



TERMS AND CONDITIONS:

These are the terms and conditions for society and group bookings in The South County Golf Club:

Booking

=====

To secure your booking you must pay the requested deposit amount as outlined in your confirmation email. This may be done by either cheque, cash or credit/debit card. Your deposit will be held by the club as insurance and your booking will not be secured unless this deposit is paid. Unsecured bookings can be deleted from the time sheets at the clubs discretion.

Cancellation Policy

=====

If you cancel your booking more than 1 week before your date of play, your deposit will remain on account for an alternative date and will not be refunded.

If you cancel your booking less than 1 week in advance, you will lose your deposit and it will be kept as a contribution to recover the lost income from the cancellation.

As tee time allocations for visitors changes from time to time, the club reserves the right to cancel or move your booking.

Size of Booking

You are required to communicate with the club no later than 5 days before the date of your booking and commit to the actual amount of tee times required. This will allow maximum utilization of the timesheet for visitors and members alike and will eliminate empty slots. The amount of players that play in these tee times will be the amount charged to the society. However, if an empty slot arises as a result of no shows, the society will be charged for that line in full, as 4 additional players.

We encourage you to communicate this particularly to all your members as it does ensure a more definite commitment or otherwise from them for the day and eliminates wasted tee times and additional costs to you.

Course Closed

=====

If you are unable to play due to the course being closed (e.g. bad weather), no charge will apply and an alternative date will be arranged.

Dress Code

=====

Normal GUI/ILGU dress code applies and will be enforced.

The following items of dress are unacceptable at all times:

- Denim jeans and jackets.
- Singlets; sleeveless or collarless shirts.
- Untailored shorts.
- Sweaters without shirts.
- Garments displaying slogans.
- Track or leisure suits.
- Trainer shoes or runners.
- Trouser legs must never be tucked into socks.
- Shirts must be tucked inside trousers.

Smart casual dress is essential in the Clubhouse. It must be clean, neat and tidy and in keeping with the high standards of the Clubhouse.

Any type of footwear worn on the course is not acceptable in the Clubhouse.

Use of Mobile Phones is not permitted on the course or in the bar and restaurant.

Payment

When you arrive at the club for your outing, you should report to the Pro Shop before beginning your rounds. After all your players have checked in with you, you need to finalize your account in full with the Pro Shop before you commence play.
